### January 29th, 5:00 p.m.

We will gather in our sanctuary for A Service of Healing this coming Sunday evening. Our service is taken from The United Methodist Book of Worship. All three of our pastors will be in attendance to lead our worship, provide Holy Communion, offer prayers of healing and wholeness and for those who desire to lay hands on and anoint with oil all persons who seek spiritual, emotional and physical healing to renew and strengthen their relationship with the living Christ. This worship experience is also designed for those who desire to spend time praying at the altar.

James (5:14-16a) calls us also to pray for and anoint the sick, that they may be healed. All healing is of God. Healing is not magic, but un-

derlying it is the great mystery of God's love. God does not promise that we shall be spared suffering but does promise to be with us in our suffering. Likewise, God does not promise that we will be cured of all illnesses; and we must all face the inevitability of death. A Service of Healing is not necessarily a service of curing, but it provides an atmosphere in which healing can happen. (Taken from The United Methodist Book of Worship.)

### Mission's Chili Lunch on Super Bowl Sunday

### Money Needed for a Missionary Pick-Up

Our Missionary in Guatemala, the Ramirez family, had two pick-ups they used to take food to orphanages and their other missionary efforts. One was stolen and the other one has over 250,000 miles on it and needs repair work. Having only half of the transportation available is definitely

hampering their efforts. A good used pick-up will cost about \$10,000—\$15,000. The Mission Committee will donate all proceeds from the Chili Lunch to this effort and is currently taking individual contributions to help them purchase another used pick-up. ## Want to Come Out and Play?

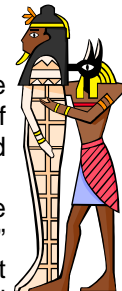
