2008 - Any Space Available?

As many of you know, I enjoy receiving newspaper cartoons. Over the years, several folks have clipped some real comical ones and sent them to me. One of those was from the "SHOE" comic strip and featured a conversation between two "birdy" characters in a medical setting that went like this:

"Mr. Loon, I have the results of your brain scan."

"Okay, Doc... Give it to me straight: What's it say?"

"Space Available!!!"

Perhaps the sender was trying to tell me something! Nevertheless, I've laughed at it ever since. It also started me thinking: **Sometimes having space available can be a very good thing.** Let's look at that thought on 2 levels:

First, if you've had to circle the block on a Sunday morning in search of a parking place here lately, having space available (or lack of) may have crossed your mind. With the onset of down right cold weather some of our older folks are having trouble because they are parking a long distance and then having to walk. If you're able to park further away and leave the close-up spots for our folks who might be visiting our church or for those of our family who physically need a close-up spot, it would be greatly appreciated.

But now concerning having space available, let me ask it on a deeper level, *"In looking at 2008, is there room within? Do we as persons have any space to offer to others and to God as we deepen our relationships with them this new year?"*

Again, overcrowding can be a problem. If we are too preoccupied with our own prejudices, worries, jealousies, there is little room for God and for others' feelings, concerns, and needs. When our heart is filled with many negatives, then where can the love be? For God often comes to us as a stranger--in people, places and relationships where we least expect to see Him.

May I encourage you to make room by sifting through and sorting out those "negatives" that which takes up your insides and make sure to keep only the "positives"; those things which are worth keeping (such as loving your neighbor and speaking well of others, etc.). 2008 will still have its struggles; however, our attitude may make all the difference.

See you in your spot this Sunday as we begin this new year together. We'll celebrate John Wesley's Covenant service in worship.

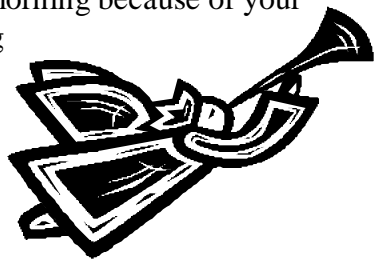

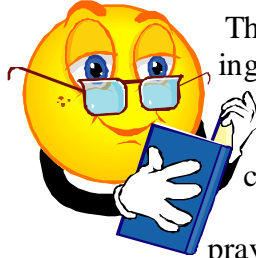

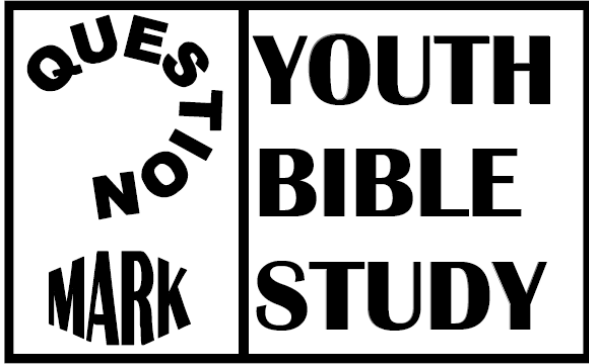
