Dear Wesley Family,

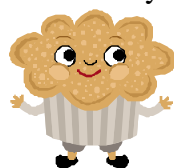

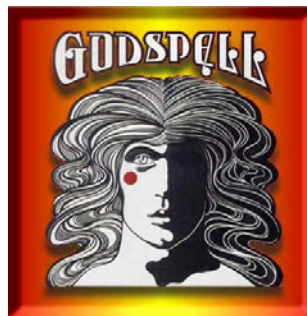

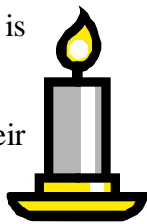
