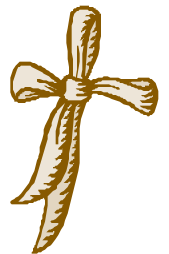

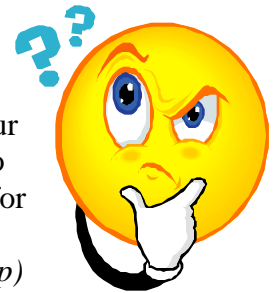

New Studies

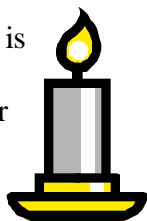
Two Studies Begin
