## From Our Pastors

### Out of the Storm

*"Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and He brought them out of their distress."*

From the time this Psalm was written, to this day, all of God's people have had to endure the storms of life. Waves of trial and hardship have pounded countless disciples of Christ. In truth, none of us are immune from the force and impact of these storms. The winds and waters of Hurricane Ike and the forces of the storms of life have impacted all in our community.

*He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed.*

Yet, what makes the storms bearable, what enables us to endure and emerge from these storms, is our trust in God's faithfulness. Our faith in God gives us the assurance that God hears our cries. Our faith in God enables us to stand firm, to not give up, and to continue on in the midst of the storms. Our faith in God assures us that God stills our storms and guides us forth from our distress. 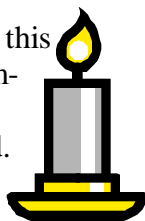
